MINISTRY OF THE MONTH



Christian Missions In Many Lands, Inc. (CMML) was established in 1921 as a nonprofit, faithbased service organization to serve missionaries from the United States serving in cross-cultural missions overseas. CMML serves missionaries that have been commended by local churches designated by the U.S.

government as Plymouth Brethren. In 1972 CMML merged with three other missionary service organizations: Voices from the Vineyard, the Fields, and the Julia Hasse Memorial Missionary Home, to form a single missionary service organization for U.S. commended missionaries.

The missionaries that CMML serves are those who are called by the Lord, commended by their local churches and look to the Lord alone for direction and to supply their financial needs without contractual links with any other agency. As a missionary service organization, CMML bridges the gap between those on the foreign field and their assemblies at home. CMML serves by facilitating prayer for missionaries, forwarding unsolicited, free-will gifts to the missionaries, and disseminating information about missionary activities. As a service organization, CMML does not send or superintend missionaries but simply serves them.
